Northwest Location Opening – Patient FAQ

Where is the new Northwest location?

Our new Northwest office is located on the corner of Linda Vista and Oracle. The office is approximately 12–15 minutes from our current 1st Avenue & River Road location.

Why is PISA opening a new location?

We are expanding to better serve our patients throughout Northwest Tucson and the surrounding communities. The new location will allow us to continue providing high-quality care while increasing access and convenience for our patients.

When will the Linda Vista office open?

We are currently planning for the office to open in August 2026. Please note that this date is tentative. We will communicate updates as they become available.

Is the Linda Vista location replacing the 1st & River office?

Yes. The Linda Vista location will replace our current 1st & River office. Additional information regarding the transition will be communicated to patients as plans are finalized.

Which providers will see patients at the Linda Vista location?

The following providers are currently expected to practice at the Linda Vista location:

Provider assignments remain subject to change based on operational needs.

Will I be required to change locations?

Not necessarily. Your current provider may not be seeing patients at the Linda Vista location and may instead be practicing at another PISA office. If this occurs, our team will work with you to schedule appointments with your provider at the appropriate location.

What if I do not want to follow my provider to Linda Vista?

If your provider relocates to the Linda Vista office and you prefer to remain at another PISA location, we will be happy to discuss alternative provider options with you. Our goal is to ensure you continue receiving quality care at the location that is most convenient for you. Any transfer of care will be coordinated carefully to ensure continuity of treatment.

What if I want to stay with my current provider(s) but do not want to go to their new location.

We believe that the best patient care comes from continuity in the setting of physician/APP teams. Because of this, patients need to routinely be seen at their providers' home office. If you are not able/willing to attend appointments at that location, we will be happy to transition you to another of our highly skilled physician/APP teams that practice at a more convenient location.
